

Playa de Cabria

Black sand beach with a few chiringuitos: walk around the northern end over the rocks to get to a more secluded beach.

Cala de San Pedro near Las Negras

Small hippie settlement reachable by foot with a small bar on the beach. Ask the locals for a boat tour along the coast.

Cazorla Natural Park

The pretty town is the entrance point to the natural park of Sierra de Cazorla with magnificent forests, river gorges and many cascades. We particularly liked the ones before Arroyo Frio (Central Cerrada del Utrero) & Rio Borosa (Cascada de la Poza).

A lovely stay option in Cazorla is Camping San Isicio: very green, small camping on multiple terraces: they also have bungalows. In the natural park: Complejo Turístico Puente de las Herrerías.

El Torcal de Antequera

Unique limestone rock formations in a natural park with nice hiking routes. Also visit Dolmen de Menga - an ancient burial site in the town of Antequera.

Alcalá la Real

From afar you see the Fortaleza de la Mota, the ancient walled city, rise high above Alcalá la Real. Let its power draw you in and feel the echoes of bygone times. A must-see for history and heritage lovers. A window in time where military and everyday elements of Muslim and Christian life blend.

Grazalema

Pretty mountain village within natural park with ancient & rare Spanish Fir (Pinsapo) trees.

Ronda

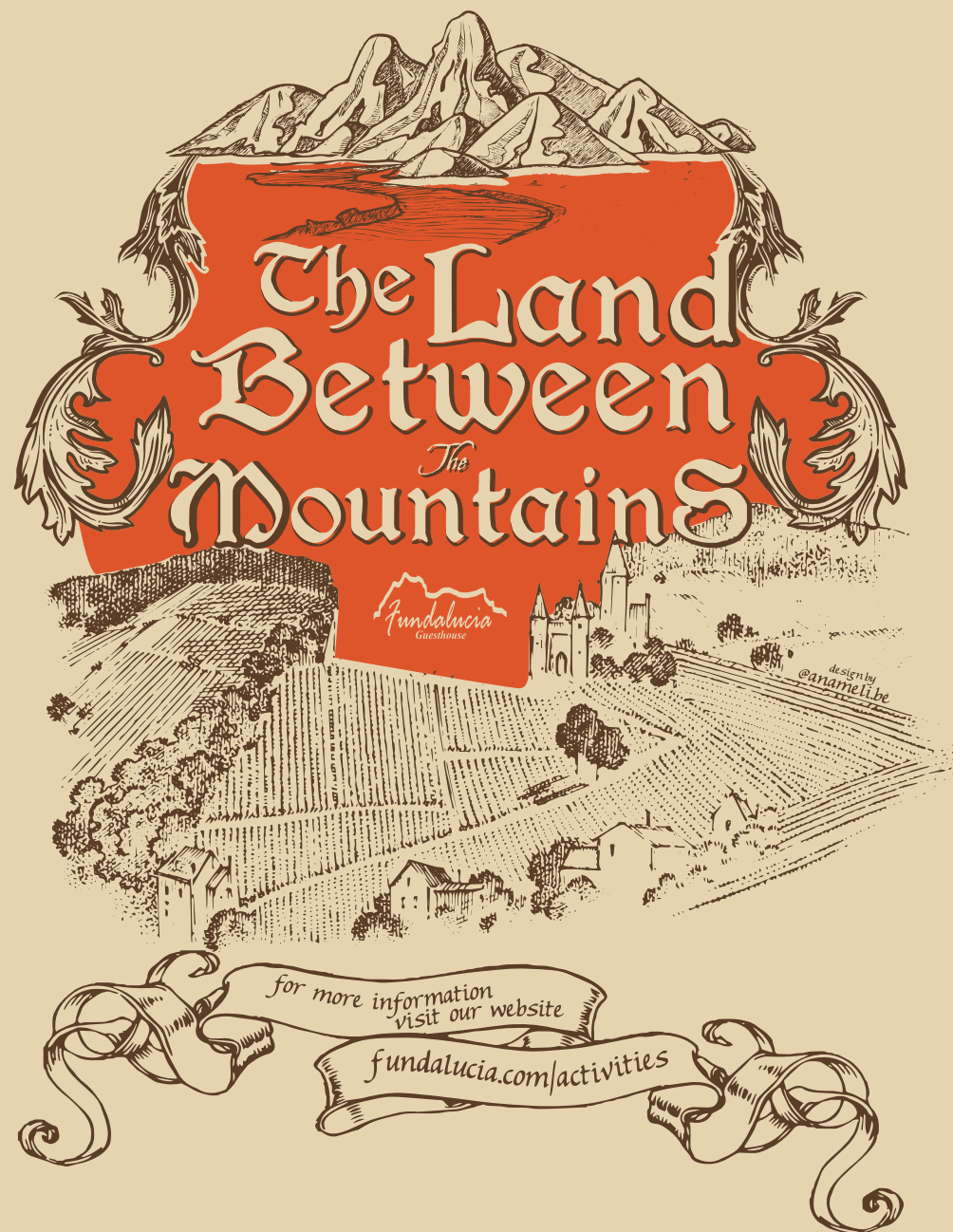
Historic charming town on two sides of an impressive river gorge. Unique stay at Casa Ronda 1808.

Olvera

"Peace comes out of me"
Fantastic views from the Arab castle & church towering over the small town.

Priego de Córdoba

Historic and artistic baroque heritage city with a series of secluded streets and corners crammed with noble houses, architectural monuments, sculptures and an old fort. Enjoy a walk around the 'balconies' above the cliff, the beautiful fountains and soak in the gentle atmosphere of the place and people.





Güéjar Sierra Rio Genil

From Güéjar Sierra follow the Sendero Vereda De La Estrella hiking trail or drive by car through the tunnels of the old tramway till Restaurante Barranco San Juan. Cross the river there and you'll find a map with many hiking options.

Pinos Genil

Beautiful green village with many bars and restaurants by the river; it's always a few degrees cooler. Visit the 400+ year old tree and watch or feed the ducks in the river. Bar Belerda has great food and very friendly staff. We also recommend baked goods from Panadería Maribel.

Small village on a steep slope overlooked by its Moorish castle with fantastic views onto Granada and the Sierra Nevada. The 8km El Goliano hiking route is a nice way to see the varied natural landscape.

Guadix

Canyon-like landscape famous for cave houses. Visit the Barrio de Cuevas & the Parroquia Nuestra Señora De Gracia. In nearby Purullena, there is a 3-story cave museum: the ground floor you walk through is where the owners live - La Inmaculada Cave Museum.

Área Recreativa del Río Dílar

Hiking trail snaking by and through the river. In the beginning there are picnic tables, later it becomes increasingly natural. Best with water shoes. Nice garden restaurant on the way - La Chimenea Restaurante Pizzeria Asador.

Barranco Río Verde

Beautiful waterfalls, pools & hiking on private property. 4km earth trek after the entrance; fee is 5€ per car and per person. They also offer canyoning adventure tours.

Take the A-4050 road from Granada to Otívar. It goes through stunning nature with magnificent views.

Rio Dúrcal, Cascada de los Bolos

Follow the water channel through a few small tunnels and then walk by and through the river till the waterfall. Best with water shoes. Eat at nearby Chambao El Vizco - a beautiful garden restaurant with very friendly staff.

La Alpujarra

Southern foothills of the Sierra Nevada with beautiful villages, such as Pampaneira, Capileira, Bubiñ, Pitres, Pórtugos, along the road with many hiking opportunities and fountains. Lovely waterfall by the Área Recreativa Rio Bermejo. Stay at Los Albergues in Pitres (only on google maps).

Nerja Caves

Very impressive limestone caves with one of the world's longest and largest stalagmites of 32 meters in height.

Frigiliana

Very pretty town in the hills above Nerja. Wander through the narrow streets of the Moorish old quarter decorated with ceramic mosaics.

Playa Marina del Este

Small and quiet pebble stone bay with a nice chiringuito that serves excellent Paella (you might have to pre-order).

As the water here is very clear, there are many diving schools in the nearby harbour.

Parque Mediterráneo

Lovely green park in La Velilla, Almunécar going all the way down to the beach.

Setenil de las Bodegas

Beautiful village with homes & restaurants built into the overhanging rocks by the river.
